Training Tiers

<p>Approved Tier 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides general content information on a topic • Suggested length of training is 1-2 hours • Can be given by a Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3 trainer or specialist • Attendance is verified by submission of roster to the Registry 	<p>Approved Tier 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presents general content and opportunity to practice using learned information and concrete application to your job. • Suggested length of training is 2-5 hours • Can be given by Tier 2, Tier 3 trainer or specialist • Attendance is verified by submission of roster to the Registry.
<p>Approved Tier 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presents general content and opportunity to practice using learned information and concrete application to your job • Suggested length of time is over 5 hours • Can be given by Tier 3 trainer or specialist • Contains an assessment component involving thoughtful application. Participant displays competency in set objectives. • Attendance is verified by submission of roster to the Registry. 	<p>Approved Tier 4 (credit based)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Criteria determined by institution of higher education • Can only be given by instructor • Attendance is verified by official transcript from institution of higher education.
<p>Registered</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides content that meets requirements for continuing education as defined by state licensing – Department of Child and Family Services. • Can be given by a Registered, Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3 trainer, or specialist • Barcodes will be issued for verification of attendance. Trainer may not be a part of the trainer approval process.
